Shipment Value Statistics of Construction Equipment for February 2025

1. General (comparisons are on a year-on-year basis)

The total shipment value of construction equipment for February consists of JPY81.6 billion for the domestic market (down 4.3%) and JPY 198.8 billion For overseas (up 2.9%), which resulted in the seventh straight month of declines for domestic and for the first time in thirteen months of increase for overseas. The grand total was JPY 280.4 billion, up 0.7% for the first time in seven straight months of increase.

2. By Market (comparisons – likewise)

(1) Domestic

- By type of equipment, construction cranes increased 4.1% to JPY15.3 billion, concrete equipment increased 92.7% to JPY3.4 billion, Foundation work equipment increased 15.7% to 4.3 billion.
- In addition to these three types, service parts increased 9.3% to JPY12.9 billion.
 However, the other six types decreased.

(2) Overseas

- By type of equipment, tractors increased 8.9% to JPY 23.6 billion, construction cranes increased 38.4% to JPY10.7 billion, concrete equipment increased 27.3% to JPY 100 million, hydraulic breakers and crushers increased 1.6% to JPY800 million, other construction equipment increased 38.1% to JPY34.1 billion. In addition to these five types, service parts increased 28.0% to JPY26.6 billion. However, the other four types decreased.
- By region, five out of the nine regions saw increased. However, the other four regions decreased.
